**Adoration: We have resumed Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament on a limited basis on the first Friday of the month between 1-3 p.m. Please wear a mask and sit (or kneel) socially distanced. Our next Adoration will be Friday, Feb. 5. (On Jan. 1, there will be Mass at 10 a.m., but no Adoration in the afternoon.)**

Despite the Supreme Court decision on church attendance, our staff has decided for now to maintain our capacity at 25 in the church and 10 in the hall; Mass is broadcast on our website, [sscolumbabrigid.org](http://sscolumbabrigid.org). You **MUST** call in for reservations, wear a mask, have your temperature taken, and sit where instructed. If the church and hall are full you can stay in your car or, if weather permits, in the Sr. Karen Garden until the time to receive Communion. Please stay posted, especially if Buffalo moves to Code Red, as things can change from week to week. (Note: already several of our Christmas Masses are nearly full!)

On Thursday, Dec. 31 we will have a Mass at 4 p.m. in English and will celebrate a bilingual Mass at 11 p.m. We will also have a "Quiet Mass" (less singing, more contemplative) at 10 a.m. on New Year's Day, Friday, Jan. 1.

Case No. 20-10322

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT, On February 28, 2020, The Diocese of Buffalo N.Y., ("Diocese") filed for protection under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code").

The Bankruptcy Court has established August 14, 2021 at 11:59 p.m. (prevailing Eastern time) as the deadline to file proofs of claim against the Diocese (the "Bar Date").

If you have a claim against the Diocese, including, without limitation, a claim related to sexual abuse committed by any person connected with the Diocese, you must file a claim on or before the Bar Date.

**Scholarships:** The Albert Lenhard Scholarship was developed to assist applicants who want to continue their formal education beyond high school at the undergraduate and graduate levels. To be eligible for the Scholarship the candidate must reside in the geographic boundaries of the Catholic Churches of Central Buffalo: Blessed Trinity, Ss. Columba-Brigid, St. Katherine Drexel, St. Lawrence and St. Martin De Porres.

The MLK Scholarship was developed to help an 8th grade student attain a Catholic High School Education. Our goal is to support our recipients so they may continue to serve in their churches, in their communities and in their world. To be eligible for the scholarship the candidate must be a member of an ethnic minority group, and must meet the criteria stated in the letter found with the application packet available in the church.
