Road to Renewal Updates: The Administration pillar met on July 10 and discussed the monthly rent for Fr. Joe and agreed upon a recommendation to be forwarded to Fr. Joe. This would be an interim arrangement until they develop a plan to allocate all family expenses. Allocation of compensation of the priests was discussed. The matter was tabled pending additional information as to the actual costs of the priests. They discussed what a central office would look like. A subcommittee will work on a list of what duties and responsibilities would lie within the Central Office. Weekly attendance at St. Lawrence has risen by about 20% since Fr. Joe's arrival.
