Have you heard about the BISON Children's Scholarship Fund? We are a tuition assistance program helping economically eligible children attend private grammar schools of their choice. BISON was founded on the belief that parents should be able to choose the school that best fits their child's needs regardless of income or zip code.

If you have families who would benefit from our program, please pass this information along to them. Please discuss the program at meetings, and talk to community members about this wonderful opportunity for the families you serve.

The application process is now open for new families: parents can visit our website at <a href="https://www.bisonfund.com">www.bisonfund.com</a> to complete a scholarship pre-application for the 2021-22 school year. The deadline to apply is February 28, 2021. All pre-applications will be entered into a lottery drawing on March 1, 2021. If a family's name is drawn in the lottery, they will receive an email with instructions on how to proceed with the application.

Scholarship amounts vary depending on the family's income, household size and the school's tuition cost. The highest scholarship amount for 2021-22 school year is \$2,500 per child. Families will be expected to contribute partial tuition towards their child's education.
